I (We),do hereby CEDE AND TRANSFER unto the Commonwealth War Graves Commission of London, England, all my (our) right and title in and to the portion of land described in the Schedule hereto containing the grave of a member of the armed forces of the British Crown who fell in the European war of 1914 to August 31st, 1921, TO HOLD the said portion of land unto and to the use of the said Commission or their successors for the purpose of erecting a headstone over the said grave and of maintaining the said grave and headstone in perpetuity subject to any Act, rules, or regulations now in force or which may hereafter be in force with regard to interments and graves.
